

Commentary on candidate evidence

The candidate evidence has achieved the following marks for each section of the assignment.

Candidate 2

The candidate was awarded **12 out of 20 marks**.

Standard A

The candidate was awarded **4 marks**.

There is significance and impact throughout, with most points addressing impact of belief and possible impact if the views presented are right, for example torment in hell, or peace of Nirvana.

Standards B, C and D

The candidate was awarded **6 marks**.

The candidate identifies two web pages and two Biblical references, and they are relevant to the question. There is very good detail on the Christian view, but the report is a bit uneven and lacks balance because the parts on Buddhism and Atheism/Humanism are less developed. They offer some analysis of the key ideas in Christianity, but the report doesn't properly analyse an issue because the question is poorly worded.

Standards E and F

The candidate was awarded **2 marks**.

The candidate doesn't offer an evaluation of the views as they are presented, but there are 2 marks awarded for the final conclusion that we can't know the answer, but maybe we can live good lives in the hope of a good afterlife.
